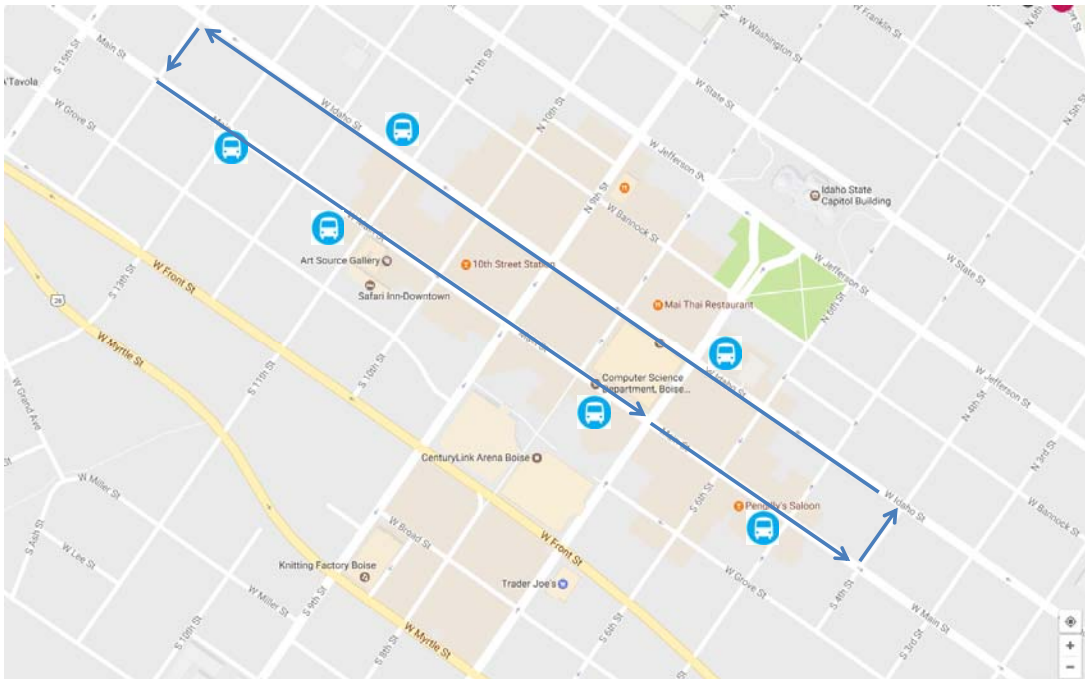


# TREEFORT MUSIC FEST

Valley Regional Transit will offer free “Treeline” shuttle service in downtown Boise. A map of the shuttle route is below. The shuttle service hours of operation are **7 p.m. to 2 a.m. March 23-25 (Thursday-Saturday)**. You also can ride any ValleyRide bus for free during the entire festival by showing the bus operator your wristband.



## Treeline shuttle stops:

- » On Main Street at 13th Street, at 11th Street, between 8th Street and Capitol (Main Street Station and at 5th and Main
- » On Idaho Street at 8th Street and at 11th Street
- » Service will be every 15 minutes

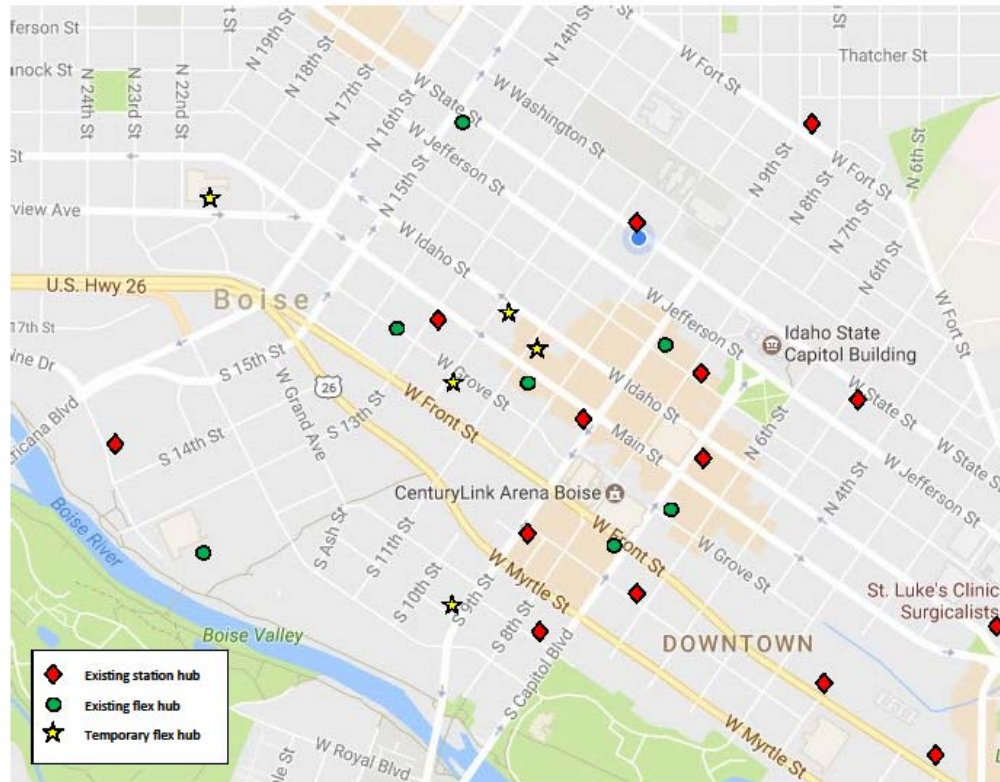
## Come help us shape future public transportation services
