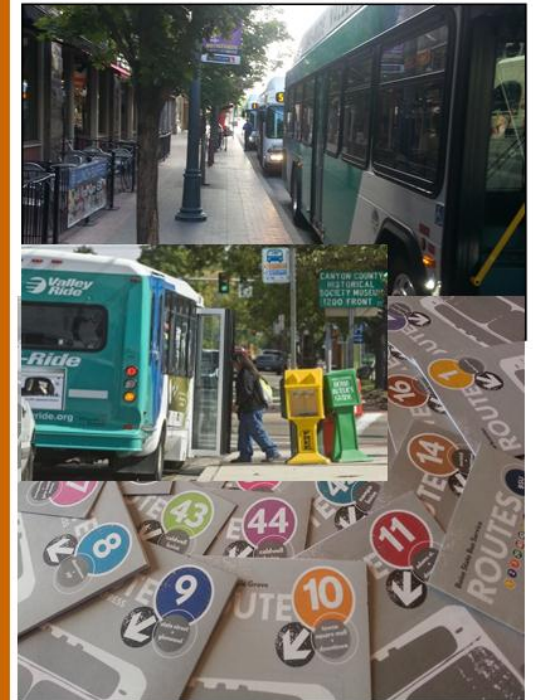

TRAVEL INDEPENDENTLY

Travel Training is for anyone, any age and ability, who is interested in riding the ValleyRide bus system.

TRAVEL TRAINING

Learn how to ride the ValleyRide bus system through our **free** Travel Training Program! A program designed to give you the independence and flexibility to use the public transportation system.

Travel training is a one-on-one or group instruction in the use of the public transportation system. You can learn the skills to travel independently and feel more confident.

The Travel Training Program begins with an initial interview and assessment. For participants under the age of 18, written parental consent must be provided. In addition to a travel trainer, ValleyRide provides each trainee with a bus pass which allows the participant to ride the fixed-route system for free during the training period.

The Travel Training Program will connect you with one of our Transit Travel Trainers to assist you to understand:

- *Trip planning*
- *Transit routes*
- *How to locate and transfer to other buses*
- *How to read and understand route maps and schedules*

- *Fares and purchasing passes*
- *Using the wheelchair lift and ramps*
- *How to position your mobility device in the bus*
- *Service animal rules*
- *How to ride independently and with confidence!*

ValleyRide's Travel Training Program allows each trainee to develop their individual goals and training is personally designed to fit the trainees learning style and needs.

Riders are given instruction on their rights under the Americans with Disabilities Act to use all forms of public transportation and their responsibilities when using the transit system.
